




Figure: Edge computing architecture overview

Break your skills into bite-sized pieces—like mastering a single Excel formula, practicing one coding function, or learning one financial term


This makes it easier to remember, boosts confidence with small wins, and helps you apply knowledge immediately.

- Practical roleplay was conducted on the "Be Proactive" theme, inspired by The 7 Habits of Highly Effective People by Stephen R. Covey.






Book Recommendation - Level Up Your Skills
